

AMENDMENT TO LICENSE AGREEMENT

17. Code of Conduct

17.2 In the event that Licensor notifies EP of any breach of this Code of Conduct section or EP has reasonable grounds to suspect that Licensor may be in breach of this Code of Conduct section then, at the written request of EP, Licensor shall allow EP and/or its authorized representatives, at its own expense, to audit Licensor’s facilities, books, records, and other documents as necessary to verify the Licensor’s adherence to this Agreement. If Licensor violates this Section and such breach remains uncured for thirty (30) days or more after Licensor’s receipt of notice, then EP may terminate the Agreement.

All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
